Prices are from Egg Clearinghouse, Inc., (ECI) Durham, N.H. and reflect trading prices for gradable nest run eggs (GNR) on ECI, a nationwide trading center for producers, packers and marketers. GNR eggs are classified by weight in 30-dozen cases, and traded in lots of either 300 or 750 cases. Prices are FOB buyers dock, and are computed Tuesday and Thursday of each week. Market Comment: RTC movement on whole birds is fair to occasionally good, but overall the demand has tapered a little at most plants. Breast items continue to clean satisfactorily while leg and leg quarters are difficult to clear under a light and unaggressive demand. Wings are fair, giblets are good. Overall slaughter is light as most plants have reduced their kill. Approximately half the number of plants in Delmarva will not be open tomorrow. Live supplies are adequate. Weights range from lighter than desired to desirable. Undertone is fully steady.


