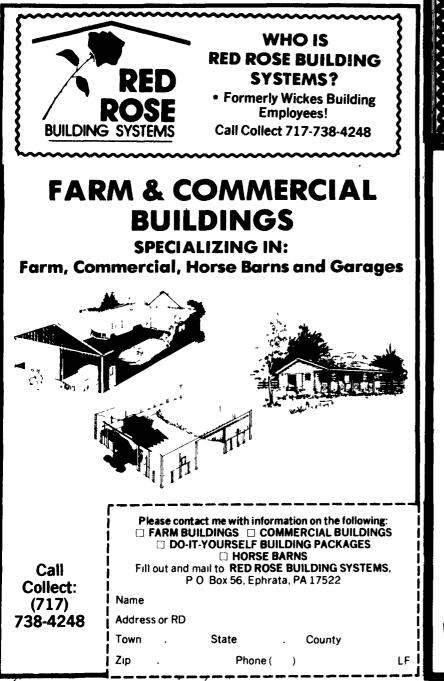
#### Lancaster Society 11
