Weekly 51 — Cattle — as compared to last week's closing prices, slaughter steers and heifers ranged 2.50-3.00 higher at mid-session, ending the week at the highest levels in five months. Storm shortened receipts responsible for part of the upturn; but other factors provided the main thrust in the advance. I.E. sharply higher boxed and carcass beef prices, aggressive packer demand, smaller numbers of available market ready cattle,

strong pricing stance of area cattle feeders. Slaughter cows 1.00 higher. Bulls steady.

Estimated five day receipts 8000; actuals a week ago 9782; last year 18125. Steers comprised 47 pct of this week's receipts; heifers 38 pct; cows 7 pct; feeders 7 pct.

STEERS: At the close three load string choice, few prime 2-4 reputation fed near 1250 lbs. 64.50. Choice 2-4 1050-1300 lbs. 62.50-64.00. Mixed good and choice 2-3 1050-1150 lbs. 60.50-62.50. Few good 59.00-60.50.

HEIFERS: Nine loads choice, few prime 2-4 1050-1100 lbs. 62.50. Choice 2-4 950-1100 lbs. 60.25-62.00,

bulk 61.00-61.50. Mixed good and choice 2-3 900-1050 lbs. 58.50-60.00. Few good 57.00-58.50.

Average of LS 214 detailed quotations for 900-1100 lb. choice steers 62.05, 1100-1300 lbs. 63.25. Average cost steers 62.88, average weight 1157 lbs.; as compared 59.58 and 1164 lbs. a week ago. Average cost heifers 60.96, average weight 1011 lbs.; as compared 58.03 and 1033 lbs. a week ago.
