of employment with the Cooperative. Henry is the supervisor for Atlantic's Area One which covers eight Southeastern Pennsylvania counties and the state of Delaware.

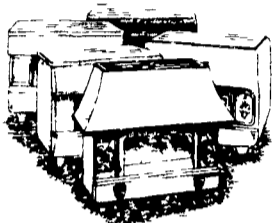

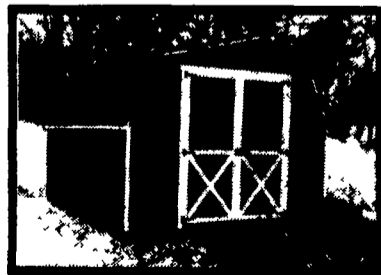
