production, swine finishing and field crops.

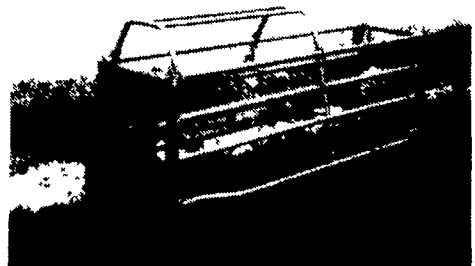
He is the son of Raymond and Mabel Bricker, of Chambersburg.

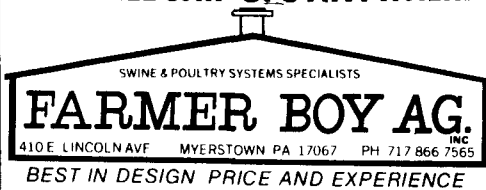

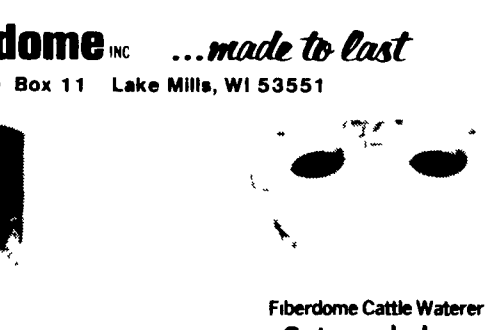
