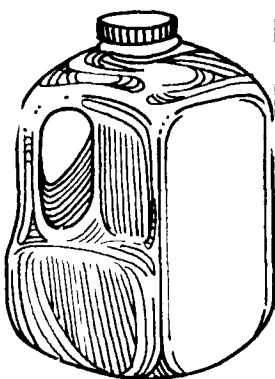
Alternative crop seminar set

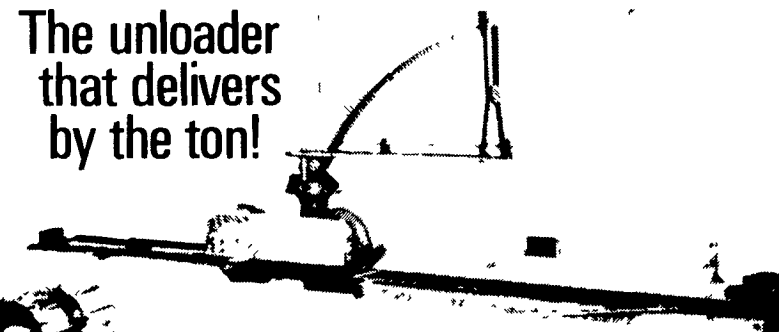
