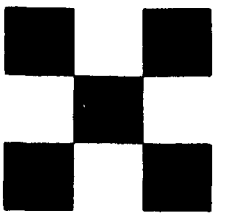

GPR Tested Boars

Only 1 out of 3 boars qualifies to become a Checker Boar

140 GPR

points and above — in the top 2% of their class

130 GPR

points and above — in the top 5% of their class

120 GPR

points and above — in the top 9% of their class

110 GPR

points and above — in the top 15% of their class

100 GPR

points and above — in the top 21% of their class

90 GPR

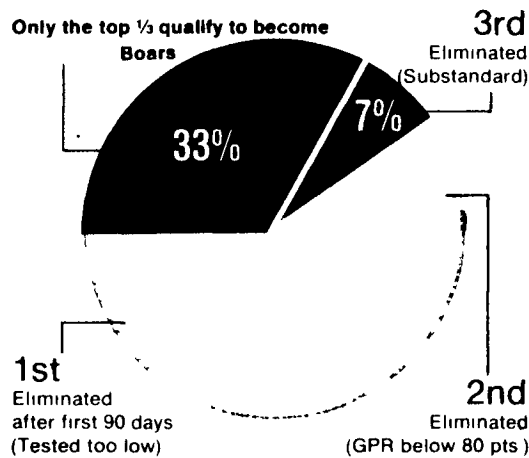
points and above — in the top 28% of their class

Boar Test Procedures

Top 50% of all boars weaned are placed on test at 10 to 12 weeks of age. Boars are taken off test when group average is approximately 210 lbs and are ranked according to growth rate and backfat.



Both Crossbred & Purebred

First, take a look at these aggressive Checker Boars

BLACKLINE A Duroc x Hamp cross that is especially recommended for a herd which has already attained a high level of sow productivity (Heavy York and/or Landrace breeding). These aggressive breeders give offspring ability to grow fast and yield good carcasses.

WHITELINE A Duroc x York cross that gives extra breeding power when there's a lot of black or red in your herd. Particularly suited to providing gilt replacements with fast growth and excellent reproduction.

M-LINE A York x Landrace cross that provides replacement gilts with the ability to farrow large litters, milk well and wean larger pigs.

HAMPSHIRE Complements red and white breeding by maximizing offspring vigor, reducing backfat, and providing good muscle.

DUROC Known for their ability to improve offspring growth rate and feed efficiency.

YORK Passes along a maternal ability that can result in larger, stronger litters.

LANDRACE A mother breed adapted to confinement that milks well and gives good pig survival.
