Crown, the Colonial Cup Steeplechase International, gave him a record of six wins in seven starts in 1983 and increased his lifetime earnings to \$138,909. The victory also made him the National Steeplechase and Hunt Association's top money-winner for the year with seasonal winnings of \$93,064.

Flatterer is just one of many outstanding horses bred by the Sheppard/Pape partnership. Among the partners' homebred stakes winners was recently-deceased Martie's Anger, who won the 1979 Colonial Cup Steeplechase and that year's Eclipse.

## N.J. plans dairy meeting

HACKETTSTOWN, N.J. — The new dairy legislation, its implications and its provisions, will be the subject of an area dairy meeting set for 1 to 3 p.m. Wednesday, in the Hackettstown High School Auditorium.

Dairymen in the northwest counties, principally, Sussex, Warren, Morris, Hunterdon, and Somerset, are urged to attend.

Keynote speaker will be Woodson Moffett, New Jersey's Director of the Division of Dairy Industry in the Department of Agriculture. He will discuss the

new bill, its intentions, its provisions and implications.

Farm Credit Service will provide a speaker and information to help the dairy farmer calculate out some of the options provided in the bill.

Representatives of the USDA's ASCS will describe procedures for making application for the milk diversion program.

Planning and coordinating this Cooperative Extension meeting are Everett Chamberlain, Warren County agent, and dairy agents in neighboring counties.

In 1980, Charme Norden 10G earned the Gold Trophy Sire award based on the showing performance of his progeny, and in the same year, he achieved Gold Seal and Gold Standard status. He now ranks 14th on the all-time list of Gold Trophy Sires.

The 8-year-old bull was sired by Norden Mischief 8D and his dam is Charme Trumode 30V.

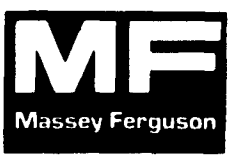
