As compared to last week's closing trade Slaughter Steers and Heifers showed losses of .50-1.00 on final rounds this week. Most of the decline occurred at midweek when dressed beef prices deteriorated and most buying interests turned

pessimistic Vis-A-Vis a near term recovery. Overall finish was mediocre with many weather stressed, muddy and lightweight cattle in the receipts. A fairly liberal outlay of cows was well received at mostly steady prices, instances .50-1.00 down.

Steers comprised 46 pct. of week's receipts; Heifers 35 pct., Cows 12 pct., Feeders 6 pct. Estimated 5 day receipts 10400, actuals last week 10028 and year ago 13639.



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
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
