Wheat standard changes

WASHINGTON, D.C. . A new class of red wheat and new procedures for rounding

dockage are two of the proposed changes to the U.S. wheat standards being considered by the

USDA.

"USDA is proposing to establish an eighth class of wheat, designated 'Red wheat' to enable the grain markets to determine the use and value of some of the new wheats being developed," said Kenneth A. Gilles, administrator USDA's Federal Grain Inspection Service. The new class would apply to mixtures of the existing Soft Red Winter, Hard Red Winter and Hard Red Spring classes.

Currently, dockage is certificated by rounding down to the nearest whole or half percent. Thus, when wheat contains between 0.00 and 0.49 percent actual dockage, no dockage figure is shown on the certificate. Wheat containing 0.5 to 0.99 percent dockage is Wheat certificated 0.5 percent; 1.00 to 1.49 percent is certificated 1.0 percent.

Under the new proposal, when the actual dockage is from zero to 0.25 percent, no dockage figure would be shown on the certificate; 0.26 to 0.75 percent would be cerficated as 0.5 percent 0.76 to 1.25 percent would be certificated as 1.0 percent.

The proposal also includes the following provisions:

- Redefines special grade Garlicky and deletes Light Garlicky;

Reduces the allowable limit for castor beans;

Changes certification procedures for the subclass Western White wheat; and

 Determines wheat of other classes, contrasting classes, and subclasses on a work portion free from dockage and shrunken and broken kernels.






