

Chester/Del. plans legislative tours

DOWNINGTOWN — Legislative tours, possible dues increase and spring dinner meeting were among items discussed by the Chester/Delaware Farmers' Association Directors at their February meeting held recently in Downingtown.

Lee Brown, Oxford; Horace Mower, Spring City; Richard Steele, West Chester; Harold Martin, Oxford; Leon Wilkinson, Landenberg and Harold Kulp, Pottstown, will be among those talking with Congressman in Washington on March 7-8. Members of the Government Relations committee will be visiting legislators in Harrisburg on March 27.

The spring membership dinner is scheduled for March 27, Denise Wilkinson, Landenberg, Women's Committee Chairman said.

Action will be taken on a possible dues increase. The Board recognized that it will be necessary to raise membership dues to cover inflationary costs. Farmers' Association members will be polled at the spring meeting concerning any increase in dues. Don Missimer, Regional organization Director, P.F.A., said that a farm management advisor has been added to the staff to assist members in making management decision. He will be visiting farmers with the farm service accountants to consider the individual farmer's questions.

Missimer suggested that Farmer's Association members consider attending a three day workshop entitled "Achieving Your Potential". Nearly all of National AFBF and State P.F.A. staff have taken the workshop. It will be held Feb. 28-March 1 in Denver, Pa. he also encouraged Board members to attend a training meeting, Feb. 24 at the Thorndale Inn.

Al Bartels, West Grove, Association President, reported that PennDOT is looking at the condition of agricultural access roads. Keith Zanzinger, County Extension Agent is coordinator of a committee working with Penn-DOT. "Representatives of farm organizations will be looking for bad roads and weak bridges. Narrow bridges and load limits that restrict farm equipment, farm supply and marketing trucks, will be put on a priority repair list," Bartels said.
