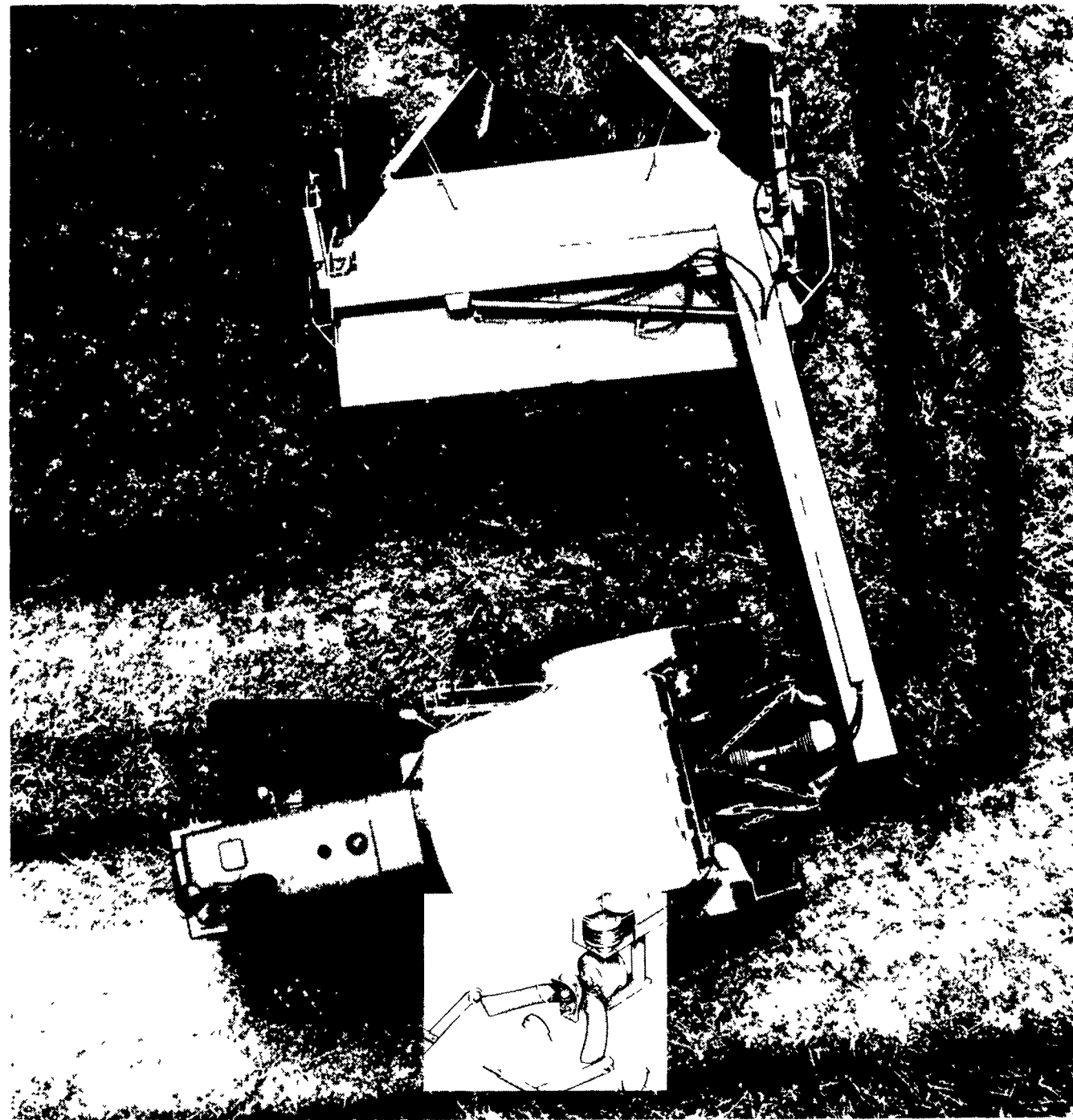
Good Morning. Demand today is fair to good and prices remain steady. Movement of bagged apples last week was 27,750 cartons, while traypack movement was 7,600 cartons. This was the result of a weekly survey of 8 growers, packers, and shippers. This indicates a stronger market than we've been seeing.

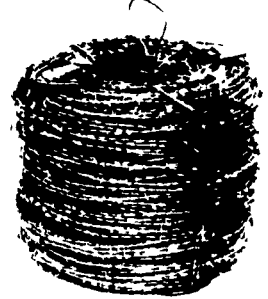

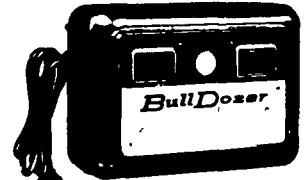

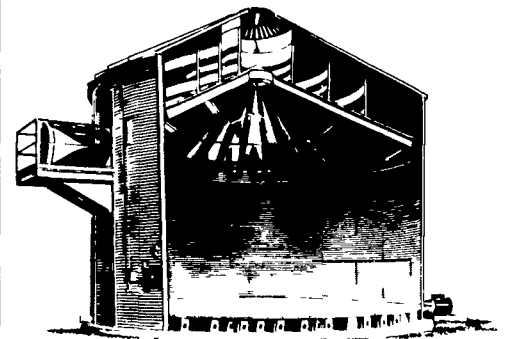
