Harry W Roach III, New Windsor has the herd with the highest average for the month of December according to figures just released by the Carroll Baltimore Dairy Herd Improvement Association

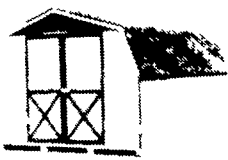
