

3 indicted in bogus farm loans

PHILADELPHIA — Eugene D. Richard, former vice president and head of the Agri-Loan Department at American Bank, Reading, and two others were indicted by a Federal Grand Jury in Philadelphia on Wednesday in an alleged fraudulent farm loan scheme that totals some \$16.9 million.

The indictment cited some 186 fraudulent agri-business loans that

were made between November, 1978 and February, 1983.

Also named by the Grand Jury in the alleged fraudulent loan conspiracy were Essie Schlamb, of New Tripoli, a former hay dealer; and Earl R. Waltemeyer, Collegetown, formerly of Walebe Farms, Inc.

According to the indictment,

more than \$3.5 million in loans went to Mrs. Schlamb and more than \$5.4 million to Waltemeyer. The remaining money was cited as including fraudulent loans made to keep the two farming operations in business or to meet payments on earlier loans to Schlamb and Waltemeyer that were both legitimate and bogus.

Charges in the indictment include conspiracy, mis-application of bank funds and making false entries in bank records.
