A fine Roybrook Starlite son, Maple is out of an EX-92-EX-MS Standout daughter who has a Lancaster Farming, Saturday, March 17, 1984–013 lifetime record of 204,070M 3.1% 6,407F. Her best record was at 6-11 365d 31,880M 3.1% 984F. Good (86) Arlinda Jet Stream Twin daughter. This cow is a high butterfat producer with 4.2% test

Also, Brooks-Twain Jason Paul, a young bull bred by Walter Brooks, Springville, has been chosen to enter Select Sires' Program for Genetic Advancement (PGA) Sire sampling system. The grandam is Brooks-Twain Pauline Profit (GP-83) with a best record of 19,480M 710F 3.6% in 296 days and the third dam is Very Good (87) with records to 24,450M 1,231F 4.5% in 305 days. The sire of this bull calf is Twin-Lawn Elevation Jason, one of the highest PD Milk sires in the January 1984 sire summaries.




Maplebound Starlight Rex, left, and Tri-Town Shadow Flash are now on the proven roster at Select Sires.


