

Select Sires reports bull data

PLAIN CITY, Oh. — As of the January, 1984 sire summary, two new Pennsylvania bred bulls entered the ranks of proven bulls at Select Sires. They are Maplebound Starlite Rex ET (VG-87) and Tri-Town Shadow Flash (G-79). Maple was bred by Donald Hostetter, Parkesburg; and Flash

is from Leola and was bred by J.Z. Nolt.

At +.23% test, Flash is Select's new top butterfat test sire. Not only is he a plus test sire but he is also +.02% on protein test. Flash is a graduate of "Select's" Program for Genetic Advancement (PGA) sire sampling system. This fine

Conductor son is out of a (VG-89) Jewel daughter with a best record of 7-7 365d 27,533M 4.2% 1,166F. His maternal grandam is also a high tester with records averaging 4.2%.

A fine Roybrook Starlite son, Maple is out of an EX-92-EX-MS Standout daughter who has a

lifetime record of 204,070M 3.1% 6,407F. Her best record was at 6-11 365d 31,880M 3.1% 984F.

Also, Brooks-Twain Jason Paul, a young bull bred by Walter Brooks, Springville, has been chosen to enter Select Sires' Program for Genetic Advancement (PGA) Sire sampling system. Based on his outstanding pedigree, this bull calf has been selected as one of only 130 Holstein bulls from throughout the United States to enter the program in 1984.

The dam of this "Select" sire is Brooks-Twain Jet Paula, a Very

Good (86) Arlinda Jet Stream-Twin daughter. This cow is a high butterfat producer with 4.2% test or higher, twice over 1,000 pounds. She has a best record of 28,000M 1,194F 4.3% in 365 days. The grandam is Brooks-Twain Pauline Profit (GP-83) with a best record of 19,480M 710F 3.6% in 296 days and the third dam is Very Good (87) with records to 24,450M 1,231F 4.5% in 305 days. The sire of this bull calf is Twin-Lawn Elevation Jason, one of the highest PD Milk sires in the January 1984 sire summaries.

Barbecue raises \$5,000

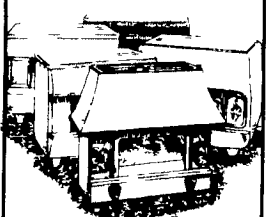

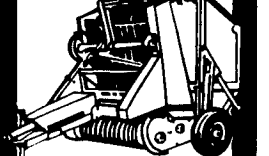
