Demand today is good and prices remain steady. Movement of 12/3# bagged apples is very good and last week's trend toward a stronger market is continuing. Sales of traypacked apples is down this week. Seven grower, packers, and shippers reported movement of 32,226 cartons of 12/3# bagged apples and 2,495 cartons of traypacked apples.
