



Reserves of corn released

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Corn entered in the farmer-owned reserve from Oct. 6, 1981, through June 30, 1982, (reserve IV) will be in release status through April.

Oat was released from the reserve Dec. 7 and will remain in release status through March.

Milton Hertz, a deputy administrator of USDA's Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service, said the decisions on the reserve were made following a review by the department's Commodity Credit Corporation of its average market prices March 1, as reported by USDA's Agricultural

Marketing Service, adjusted to reflect the market price received by farmers.

On March 1, the national average adjusted price of \$3.18 per bushel for corn was 3 cents above its reserve IV release level. The national average adjusted price for oat March 1 was \$1.75 per bushel, 10 cents above the commodity's reserve release level.

The selected major markets for corn are Kansas City, Minneapolis, Omaha, and St. Louis. The daily market reviewed by the CCC for oat is Minneapolis.

Hertz said the adjustment factors used to determine approximate

farm price levels from quoted daily major-market (or terminal) prices on March 1 puts the factors for corn and oat at 1 cent for March, an unusually small adjustment level. For comparison, Hertz said, the February factors were 7 cents for corn and 23 cents for oat.
