Next, add 2 quarts of surfactant to every 100 gallons of spray solution. Boom-apply at 5-10 gallons of water per acre when your quackgrass is 8 to 12 inches tall. (Wait for this stage of growth so Roundup can translocate better throughout the rhizome mass.) Then wait at least 3 days before tilling.

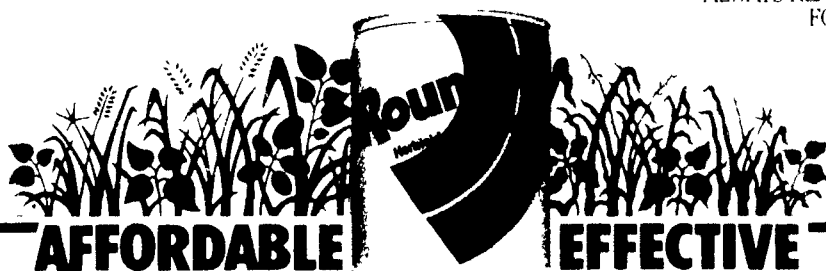
