John's son, Jack, became president of the business when his


father retired 17 years ago. Jack says the sales volume has increased most years, but added that the last few years have been a little slow.


On March 1, Saums entertained about 200 people at their annual open house. The business serves the area within a 50-mile radius, Saums said.

In addition to the family, Saums has four other employees, including parts man, Jim Smith.






