


One of the oldest dealers in Lancaster County, L.H. Brubaker Inc., has been part of the A-C team for 52 years.

"The decision-making software program works on a portable computer and printer which the equipment dealer can take into the farmer's home or office for convenience," he said

L.H. Brubaker of Lancaster was founded in 1932 by Lester Brubaker on a farm along the Strasburg Pike, several miles south of the firm's present location.

By 1939, growing pains had forced Brubaker to move to larger facilities. Sawing his shop building in half, the owner trucked each half to the company's present location, assembling the building on a new foundation and cinching the building together with steel cables.

In just seven years L.H. Brubaker had grown from four to 21 employees selling 125 new Allis-Chalmers tractors during 1939.

The tirm's growth continued resulting in the acquisition of Brubaker's Lititz location at 700 Woodcrest Avenue in 1946. Both stores were operated by Lester Brubaker, until 1973 when the Lancaster store was purchased by Park E. Lefever and his wife Sara Lee. Previous to this, Brubaker had sold his Lititz location to his brother Roy Brubaker, the firm's current owner.

Retaining the company's original name, Lefever soon erected a new shop building to accomodate the larger A-C tractors and equipment.

With a total of 12 employees, some of Brubaker's key personnel include Salesman, John Tompkins, Shop Foreman, Ken Ebersole, and Lawn and Garden Shop Foreman, Richard Wittlinger.


