

# ET heifer tops York-Adams Calfarama

YORK — An ET heifer topped the York-Adams Calfarama sale Tuesday evening at the York Fairgrounds selling for \$1550.

Cedar Lawn-Vu Apache Roxie-ET, born January, 1983 is sired by Chapel Bank Apache. Her dam is an EX-91 Citation R Maple daughter with lifetime records over 150,000 milk and 5,300 fat. The

granddam is Lakefield Fond Hope daughter, scored VG-89, with lifetime records of over 185,000 milk.

The top seller was consigned by Em Tran, Inc., of Elizabethtown and purchased by Daniel Albright, Landisburg.

Second high-selling consignment, at \$1500, was Kingway I-Star Winter, consigned by David King, Delta, and purchased by

Lela Mummert, East Berlin

Sired by Penstate Ivanhoe Star, the January 1982-born heifer is from a GP-84 daughter of Elevation, with production records over 21,000 milk. Her granddam is scored VG-87, sired by Kingstead Rock Aaggie.

Christopher Smith of Hanover purchased the third high seller at \$1075, consigned by Yellow Buttercup Farm, East Berlin.

An October-born heifer, Yellow Buttercup Dairyman Sue is by Arlinda CAR Dairyman, from an Elevation dam with records over 18,000 milk and a 4 percent fat test.

Granddam of the heifer is a GP-83 Ivanhoe Star, with records over 22,600 milk and a 4.1 percent test. Third dam is GP-81.

A total of 38 head sold at the sixth annual Calfarama, with a sale average of \$661.

## Md. bull tops gain test

STREET, Md. — A purebred, polled Charolais bull bred and owned by John W. Stump, of Street, Md. finished as the top performer over 218 bulls of all breeds in the recently completed 140-day gain test conducted by the West Virginia University Cooperative Extension Service.

The bull, JS Enterprize R311, a March 1983 calf sired by RCC Royal Enterprize, out of a daughter of GC Supreme 883, completed the test on March 6 weighing 1487 pounds, with an average daily gain of 4.51 pounds, and a weight per day of age of 4.41 pounds.

This outstanding bull, along with approximately 130 others will sell in the 17th Annual West Virginia Performance Tested All Breed Bull Sale on Thursday, March 29, beginning at 11 a.m. at the WVU Reymann Memorial Farm 1 mile north of Wardensville on State Road 259.

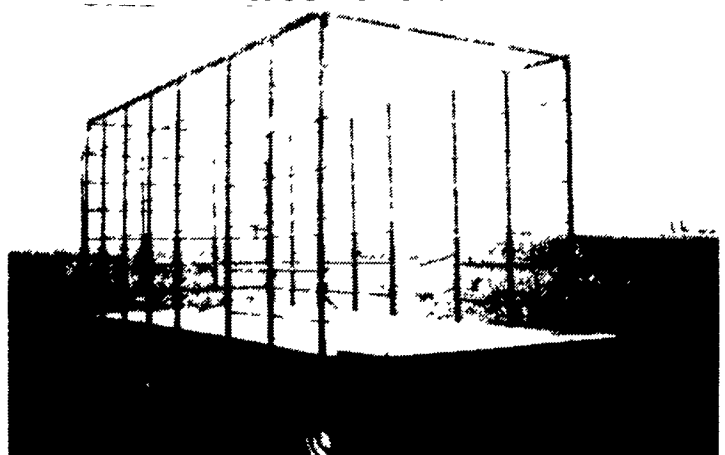

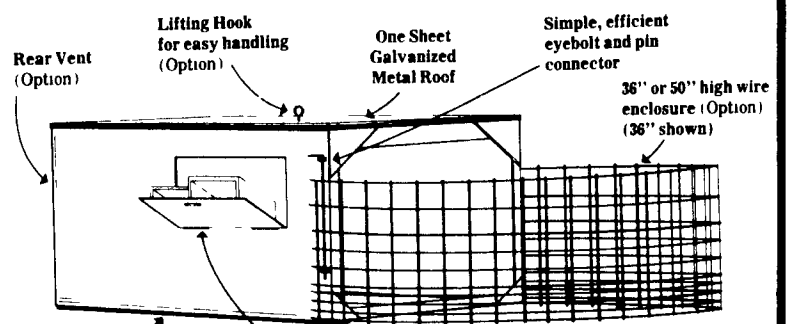
