

Salisbury to discuss field runoff

WHITE HORSE — Salisbury Township officials in Lancaster County have called a meeting among farmers for 7 p.m. Wednesday, March 28, in the White Horse Fire Hall to discuss the need for improving soil conservation practices in the township.

Scheduled to speak at the meeting is Bob Gregory, administrator of the Lancaster County Soil Conservation District; and Clair Witwer, vo-ag teacher at Pequea Valley High School.

A representative of the township supervisors said the session is being called because of the increasing number of complaints from non-farming township residents about the water, soil and

mud running from farm fields onto township roads.

The goal of the session is to encourage voluntary cooperation among farmers to correct and prevent runoff, which is not only causing safety hazards and premature deterioration of roadways but is resulting in the

loss of large amounts of valuable topsoil.

Township officials stress that voluntary cooperation is necessary or more stringent mandatory measures may become required.

All township farmers are encouraged to attend the session.

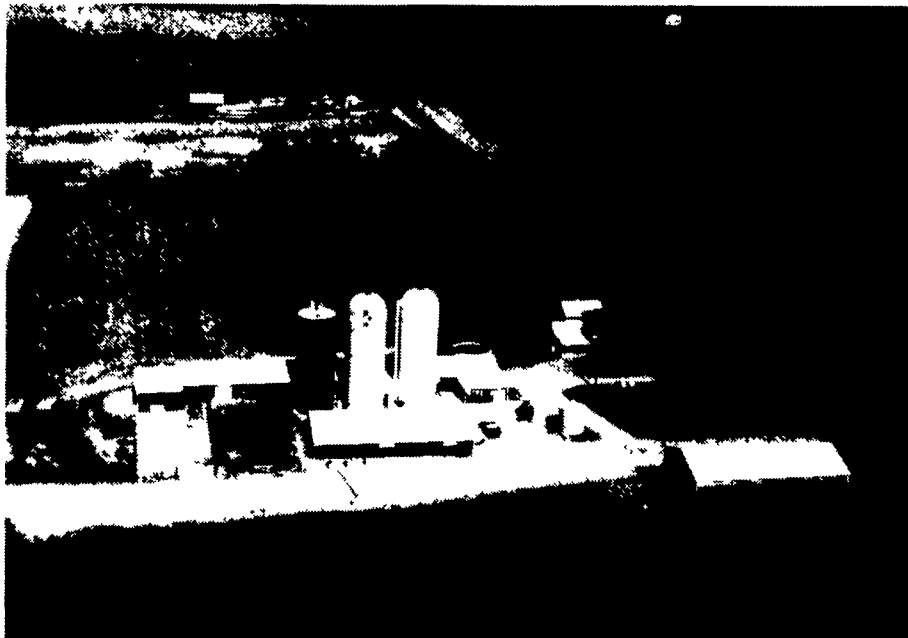
