February Report

Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 7,084 cows in 120 herds were on production testing in February according to Duane G. Duncan, County Agent. Of the 98 herds on DHIA, 34 herds has an average fat production of 600 pounds. During the month 74 completed their 305 lactation with 650 lbs of butterfat. 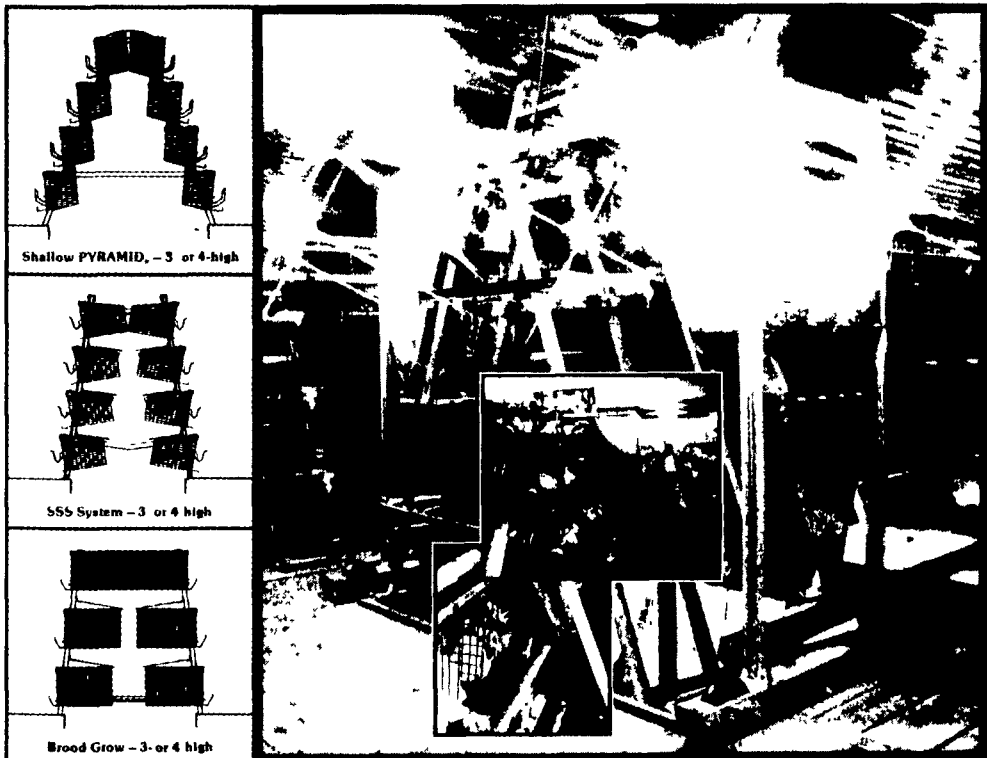

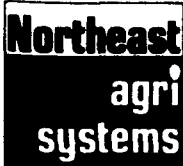
