### **Omaha Cattle** Thursday, March 29

Weekly Cattle 51 Slaughter steers and heifers ranged 50-1.00 higher for the week with an advancing beef market lending encouragement to the upturn. Day to day demand proved good not only from packers, but also from buyers of steers suitable for a short turn in the feedlot. Overall finish ran less attractive than recent weeks with muddy cattle presenting serious problems to the trade. Cows 1.00-1.50 higher. Bulls steady.

Estimated 5 day receipts 9750, actuals last week 8610 and last year 11413. Steers comprised 46 pct of the week's receipts; heifers 38 pct; feeders 7 pct; cows 8 pct.


Agricultural Agent.
