February Report

LOCK HAVEN — Paul L. Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall, PA, led the Clinton County Dairy Herd Improvement Association for February, 1984.

The top herd in the Clinton County DHIA for February is owned by Paul Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall, while the cow completing the highest lactation was owned by Paul L. Courter, RD#2, Mill Hall.

The top herd of Registered Holsteins completed the month with a Rolling Herd Average of 18303 pounds of milk per cow yielding 698 pounds of butterfat.

Other top herds were — Tom & Grace Nicholas, RD #2, Loganton, 17866 pounds of milk, 697 pounds of butterfat.

— Terry & Deb Dickey, RD #1, Box 78, Mill Hall, 18027 pounds of milk, 687 pounds of butterfat.

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or less was JoJo, a Registered Holstein owned by Paul L. Courter, RD #2, Mill Hall. JoJo produced 20985 pounds of milk testing at 4.4 percent, yielding 917 pounds of butterfat in 305 days.

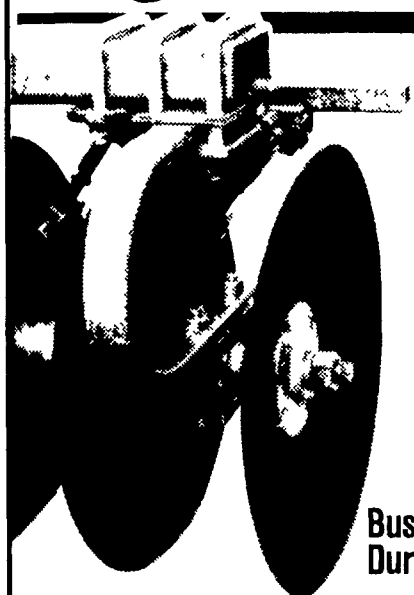
