





Ag policy meeting April 18

WASHINGTON, D.C. Secretary Agriculture John R. Block has encouraged strong public participation in an April 18 Chicago meeting he is calling to further discuss food and agriculture policy.

The meeting will begin at 10 a.m. at the Ramada Hotel O'Hare, 6600 North Manheim Road, near the Chicago O'Hare International Airport.

"This will be a listening session on farm policy," Block said. "It will be a meeting in which individuals and organizations will have an opportunity to express their views to the secretary of agriculture and other administration policy leaders."

The session will be a continuation of similar sessions with agricultural leaders held in Washington last summer and on Block's Illinois farm last fall.

Block said as many people as possible will be given a chance to make oral presentions, but it may be necessary to establish a time limit. Anyone may submit full written comments whether or not they participate at the listening session.

Those wishing make an oral presentation should write or call John Kermicle, room 226-W, USDA, Washington, D.C. 20250; (202) 447-4737, prior to April 12. Presentations will be scheduled so that participants will know in advance what time they will be heard.

"Although it is still uncertain how many of these listening sessions will be held throughout the country, we will definitely have one in the West," Block said. 'There will also be more meetings on the issue in Washington, D.C.''
