

PPF marks record banquet attendance

HERSHEY — The Pennsylvania Poultry Federation set an attendance record on Thursday night as 1,773 people jammed the Hershey Convention Center to attend the organization's 1984 Fund Raising Banquet.

During opening remarks, PPF Executive director John Hoffman expressed his surprise and elation with the responses and thanked the poultry industry for uniting against the devastating flu epidemic.

Hoffman recognized the accomplishments of PPF Top Salesman for 1984, Earl Birk of

Pennfield Corporation, and congratulated those named Industryman of the Year, including Broiler Industryman Benjamin Burkholder, Egg Industryman Raymond Sauder, and Thomas Bross, Jr., outstanding Turkey Industryman.

Others honored at the banquet included Agriculture Secretary Penrose Hallowell, Pa. Poultry Queen Brenda Hershey, and PPF Chairman of the Board Richard Moyer.

Taking the podium briefly, Moyer credited John Hoffman with

building a Federation within the past 10 years that is strong enough to deal with problems of the magnitude of the Avian Influenza epidemic.

Following the dinner, banquet-goers were entertained by country music star Reba McEntire, and comedian David Brenner.

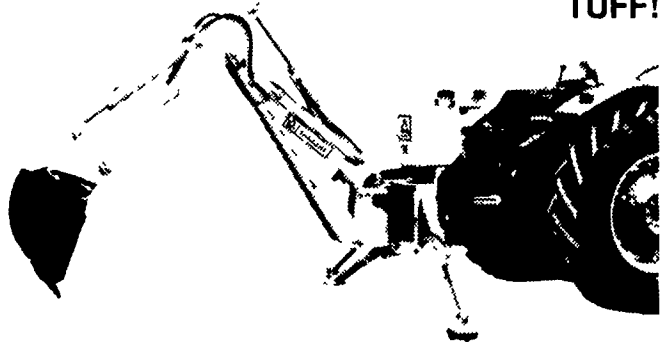

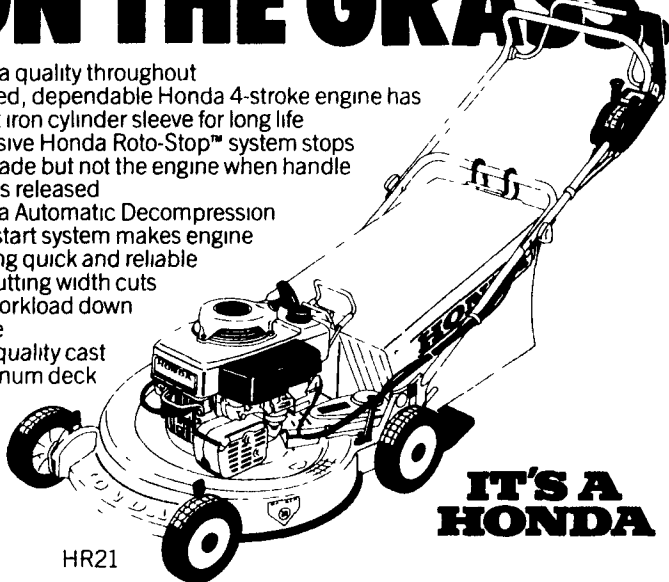
