

## CowBelles to hold annual meeting

SYRACUSE, N.Y. — Pennsylvania women interested in beef cattle production and beef promotion have been invited to the Region I meeting of the American National CowBelles May 2 and 3 at the Sheraton Inn at Syracuse.

The New York CowBelles are hosting this annual meeting for interested women and CowBelles from 17 states including Pennsylvania, New England, Ohio, Michigan, Kentucky, and Indiana.

Eldora Benson of Potsdam, chairman of the Region I meeting,

said guest speakers will include New York Agriculture and Markets Commissioner Joseph Gerace and Frances Owens of Lubbock, Tex., president-elect of the American National CowBelles.

The two-day program will begin with registration, luncheon, a tour to a furniture factory, and an informal evening program with an exchange of ideas on beef promotion and other projects.

The CowBelle groups will bring items for an auction. The May 3 program will include a presen-

tation by meat science specialist Terry Dockerty of Cornell University on "Do You Know Your Cuts of Beef?" and a discussion of beef cattle production in New York State by Peter Comerford of the N.Y. Department of Agriculture and Markets. Talks by the guest speakers and other events will be included.

Mrs. Benson emphasized that the meeting is open to all in-

terested women whether there is an active CowBelle organization in their state or not.

### Fruit Leather

Puree raw or cooked fruit using as little juice as possible. The thicker the less drying time. Then spread evenly and thinly in a jelly roll or cake pan. Pans may be lined with plastic wrap or just spread lightly with grease. Put on heat. You can put it in the oven at 125 or 150 degrees with the door open or sun dry it. Leather is dry when the surface isn't sticky. Loosen edges with a knife and pull off. If it pulls apart, it isn't dry enough. If it sticks, it is too dry. Add a thin layer of fruit or wet with a little water and dry again. Roll up as a jelly roll. Leather keeps for one month at room temperature, three months in refrigerator or one year in the freezer.


