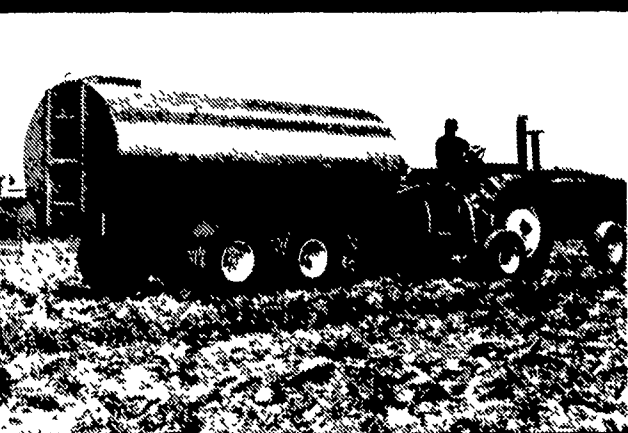

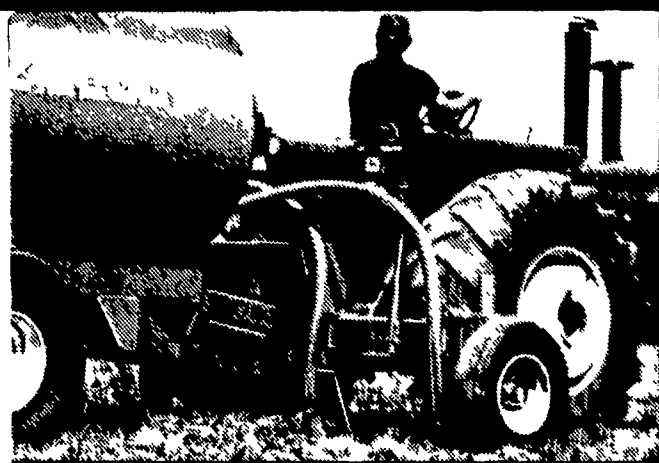

- 1 The hip supporting bars are contoured and padded. They surround the hip joints evenly distributing the pressure making it more humane.
- 2 It is compact and easily positioned being much shorter than most hip clamps. This gives ample clearance anywhere inside the frame of the "COW BUOY". It also allows the operator access to "Downer" cows in hard to get places.
- 3 Very easy to adjust and secure, the linkage on adjustment mechanism reduces effort required to turn adjusting screw.
- 4 It has a detachable handle easily removed by pulling a snap pin. This prevents the adjusting screw from getting caught or bent.
