

Establishing a pattern for safe suffered an accident said that it was chemical related. Lowest reported accident rate was in the automotive area, with 6.0 percent. Farm machinery was greatest, followed by falls and miscellaneous types of mishaps. Livestock related accidents accounted for 8.6 percent of those reported.
