During the month there were 130 herds with 7,149 cows processed in the D H I A program, according to Russell C Seward, County Agent Production ranged from a high of 62 7 pounds of milk testing 3 7 percent fat, to a low of 22 5 pounds of milk, testing 5 2 percent fat

In the owner sampler program there were 25 herds with 980 cows being processed The herds ranged from a high of 54 1 pounds of milk, testing 3 7 percent fat, to a low of 27 9 pounds of milk, testing 3 7 percent fat

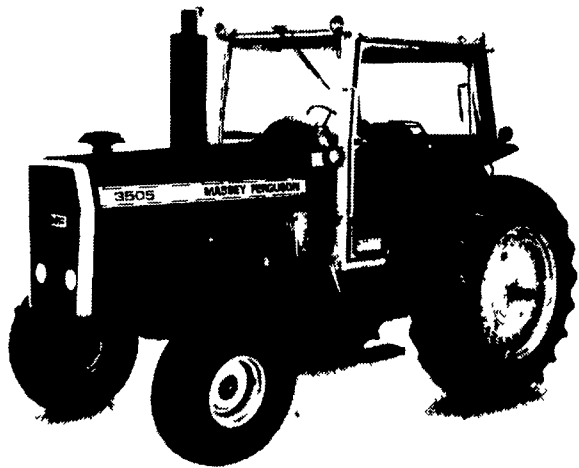

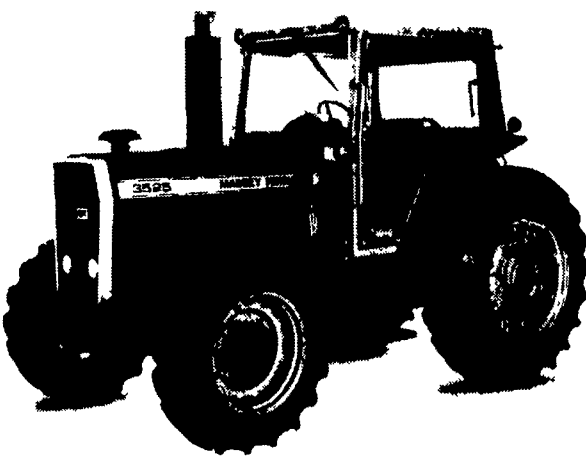

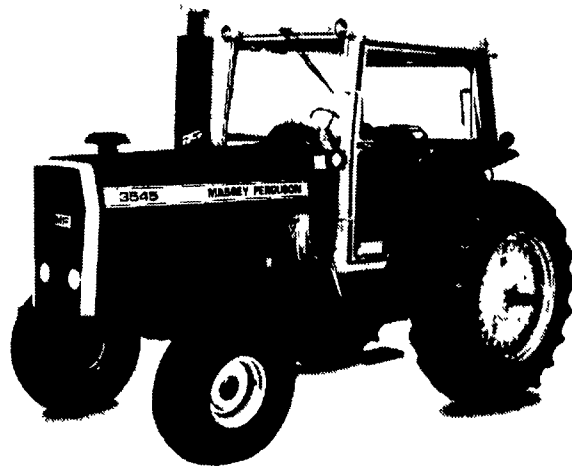
