The Master's Award was presented to Russellville Grange for having the most members in attendance.

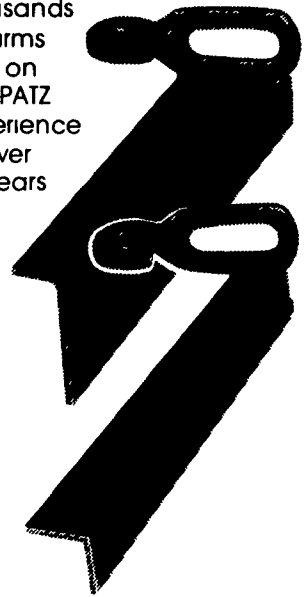
Pumpkin seeds were distributed for the contest at the October meeting.
