When called upon to perform, the frogs will be placed on a tarp about 20-feet by 20-feet in the center of a 12-foot circle. At this time the human "jockey" will try to jump the frog.

After the frog is placed in the center cirle, he cannot be touched until after the third jump. However, the "jockey" can jump up and down, scream and shout to encourage the frog to leap.


Two judges will determine the jump lengths after the third hop, skip or jump. The frog will be allowed 15 seconds on each jump. He will be disgualified if he does not jump within the allotted time.

Last year's event was won by the Lewandowski family. Jennifer Lewandowski, 19-months old, claimed first prize while her 4year-old brother, David, captured second place. Jennifer's frog, Jenny I, jumped 7'2" to claim the victory and Frederick, David's frog followed, jumping 7'2" also.





