LOCK HAVEN — Paul L. Courter, RD#2 Box 490, Mill Hall led the Clinton County Dairy Herd Improvement Association for March, 1984

The top herd in the Clinton County DHIA for March is owned by Paul L. Courter, RD#2, Box 490, Mill Hall, while the cow completing the highest lactation was owned by Walk Way Farms No. 2, Box 212, McElhattan, PA

The top herd of Registered Holsteins completed the month with a Rolling Herd Average of 18378 pounds of milk per cow yielding 701 pounds of butterfat

Other top herds were

Tom & Grace Nicholas 17830 pounds of milk 697 pounds of butterfat

Terry & Deb Dickey 18090 pounds of milk 684 pounds of butterfat

Anthony & Caroline Graine, 18828 pounds of milk 658 pounds of butterfat

The cow completing the highest lactation of 305 days or less was #4, a 5-year-old Holstein owned by Walk Way Farms #2, #4 produced 24641 pound of milk testing at 3.5 percent, yielding 869 pounds of butterfat in 305 days

Other top producing cows were:

Leslie owned by Richard L. Schenck, RD#2, Box 500 Mill Hall, 22930 pounds of milk 3.7 percent, 852 pounds of butterfat

#18, owned by Paul Dotterer, RD#2 Box 505, Mill Hall 24207 pounds of milk 3.5 percent, 839 pounds of butterfat

#47, owned by Walk Way Farms No. 2 Box 212 McElhattan 20818 pounds of milk, 3.8 percent, 800 pounds of butterfat

Becky owned by Samuel S. King RD#1, Mill Hall 20965 pounds of milk, 3.8 percent, 792 pounds of butterfat

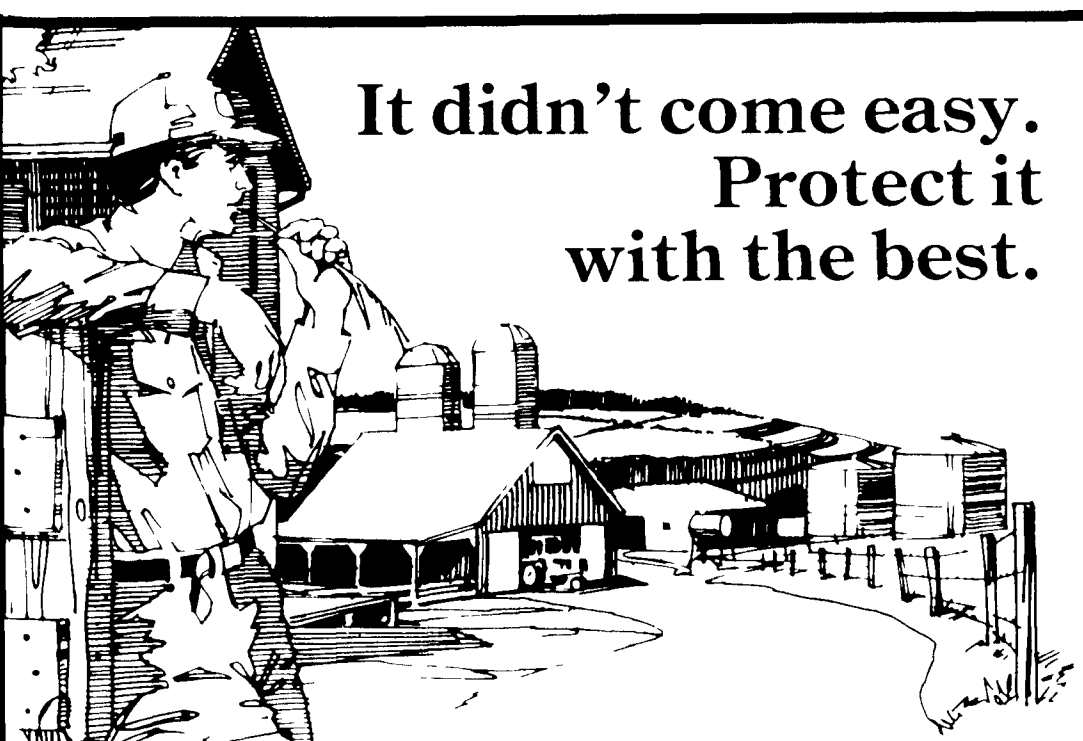
