

# David Wilson selected as IFYE Ambassador

NEW CASTLE — David J. Wilson, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harold Wilson of Portersville R2, has been selected as an International 4-H Youth Exchange Ambassador to Switzerland, representing Pennsylvania. The six-week exchange program will

emphasize dairy farm practices and living.

Wilson will be one of twelve selected Ambassadors from across the United States on the Dairy program exchange, sponsored by the Pennsylvania Cooperative Extension Service, Friends of 4-H

and National 4-H Council. He will be traveling June 10 to August 1, 1984.

While in Switzerland, Wilson will live and work on dairy farms for two weeks each and live with host families. His first stay will be around Berne, the country's

capital city. Dave will also visit dairy and agricultural industries, speak to farm groups and participate in rural youth group activities.

Wilson, a former Lawrence County 4-H member for eleven years, served on Lawrence County's Dairy Bowl Quiz Team, which placed 2nd at the state level the past two years. Wilson has showed his dairy cattle at local, district, state and national shows.

He has attended as Lawrence County's delegate to 4-H State Capital Days and Citizenship...Washington Focus and was a member of Leadership Council at the 1983 Pennsylvania 4-H Leadership Congress. He was chosen and recognized as 1982 Outstanding 4-H Member and also received the 1982 Beaver-Lawrence Junior Holstein Dairy Club Member award.

Wilson now serves as the Northwest Pennsylvania District

Holstein Junior Executive Committee alternate. He is currently a 4-H Leader for the 4-H Yankee Dairy Club.

Wilson, a 1982 graduate of Lawrence County Area Vocational Technical School, will be available for speaking engagements pertaining to Swiss Dairy farms, family life and cultural experiences after September 1.

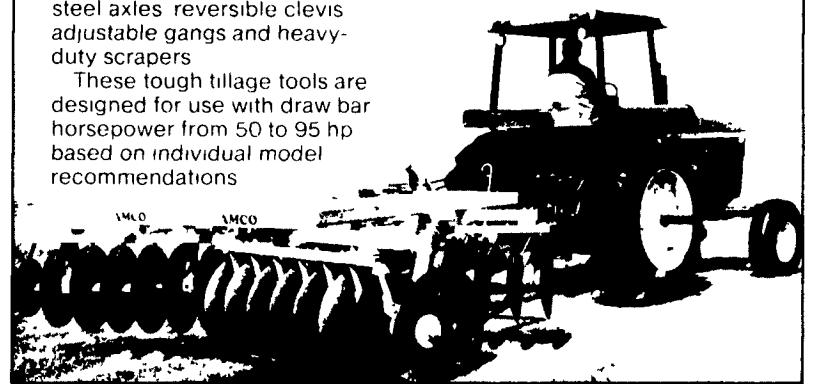

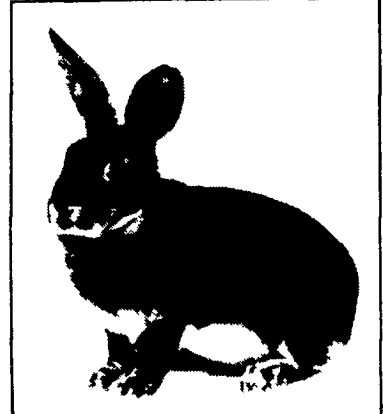
