

Md. gets tobacco grants

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — Representatives of the R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company at Winston-Salem, N.C., visited College Park recently to present checks totaling \$10,000 to

agricultural administrators at the University of Maryland.

Of that amount, \$5,000 will be used to help continue a tobacco production education and computer training program by the

university's Cooperative Extension Service, while the other \$5,000 was earmarked for a discretionary grant to be used by the provost of the Division of Agricultural and Life Sciences.

Components of the tobacco Extension funding plans include: County agent training in tobacco production methods; Young tobacco farm seminars; Improved educational resource materials; Computer development for tobacco education.

The provost's discretionary grant is intended for enhancement

of academic programs in the university's Division of Agricultural and Life Sciences. A similar grant last year was used for two purposes: to provide excellence awards to four faculty members in the areas of Extension/service, teaching, research and outstanding young faculty member; and to contribute toward the purchase of computer terminals for a proposed agricultural microcomputer

training laboratory at the College Park campus.

Since 1977, R.J. Reynolds has contributed \$94,876 to help support tobacco research, Extension and academic programs at the University of Maryland. The company's contributions to similar activities at land-grant universities in all tobacco-producing states have totaled approximately \$5 million since 1962.
