## Milk regulation to continue

**HARRISBURG** — The Pennsylvania Milk Marketing Board was ordered by the federal district court Wednesday to continue regulation of minimum retail prices for lowfat and skim milk products.

In a hearing held in Harrisburg, U.S. Judge Sylvia Rambo ruled the continuation of a federal restraining order blocking PMMB's April 16 decision to temporarily suspend minimum prices on lowfat and skim milk. The restraining order will remain in effect until the Milk Marketing Board holds hearings this summer to decide if minimum prices should be adjusted or suspended permanently.

On April 16, PMMB had approved the temporary deregulation of minimum milk prices. Judge Rambo blocked that decision with a temporary restraining order until the Board could schedule hearings to discuss minimum retail price settings for lowfat and skim milk.

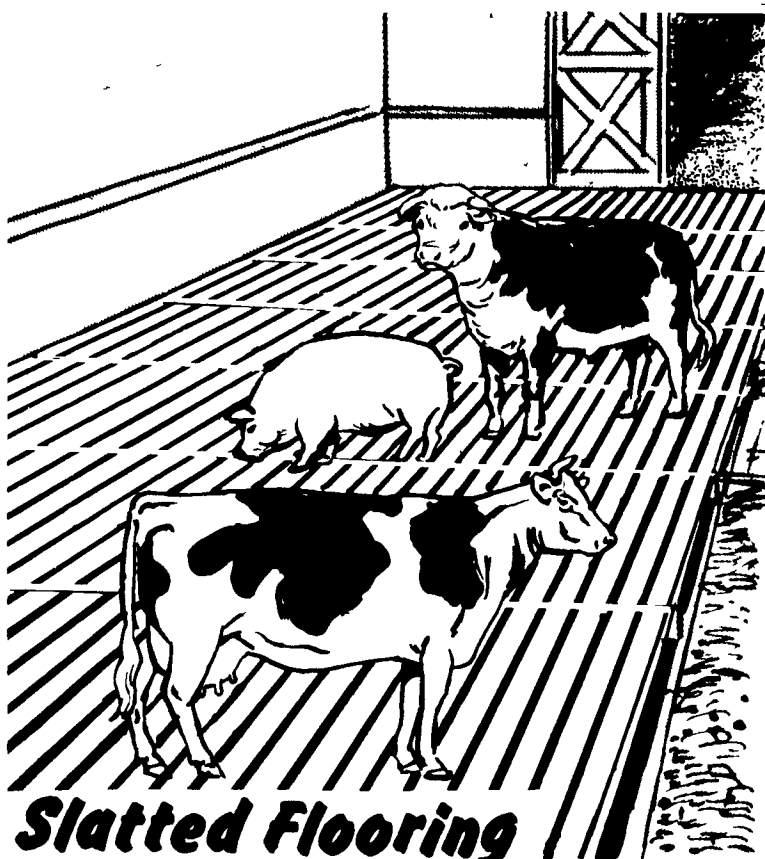

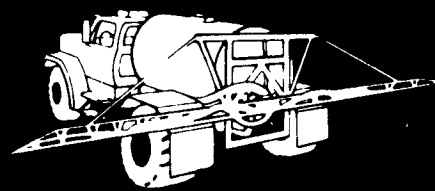
