We are liquidating all remaining stock, antiques and collectibles, equipment and fixtures at the North End location. This sprawling facility will be torn down. Van Buskirk's High Street store, established 1861, will conduct business as usual.

### SATURDAY, MAY 26 - 10 A.M.

On this day we will be selling out the antique furniture department including many fine pieces on display at the downtown store. Walnut marble top bureau w/hidden drawer; several other marble top pieces, some with mirrors, some with white marble, some refinished; ornate needlepoint side chair; piano stool w/glass feet; oak hall rack; mahogany chest on chest; fancy oak fainting couch; fancy sofa; walnut Eastlake needlepoint chair; ladder back chairs; large Eastlake mirror; dovetailed pine chest; Penn Oak nickel plated pot belly; Estey walnut pump organ; Empire sideboard w/ribbon molding; clothes tree w/cloven foot base; fancy lamps from all periods; marble topped burl walnut dresser; walnut washstand - actually, we have a surplus of cupboard type washstands in a variety of woods and styles; maple desk (contemporary); stoneware (old and new); kero lamps (old and new); set of 6 cane seat chairs; brass and copper items; dark marble bureau w/fancy Eastlake mirror farm bell; large walnut wardrobe w/carved ornament; corner chair; Empire card table; cottage chests; nite stands and open washstands; redone 19th Century Bent oak wheelchair w/cane seat and back; row of glass front floor to ceiling cases; we also have a row of oak and oak period chests and bureaus; some rough, others redone, some serpentine, some bow front, some straight, some having mirrors; wicker seat and back parlor chairs from the twenties; jelly cupboard; grand walnut sideboard w/carved top; sad irons; 3 Pennsylvania settees; oak 50 drawer counter top parts cabinet; Empire chests of drawers; mahogany sideboard; multi-seat school bench; large refinished walnut chest of drawers; dovetailed blanket chest w/bracket feet; parlor tables and vintage lamp stands; walnut and oak picture frames; dovetailed dry sink w/lift lid; high style dining room cupboard w/fancy grain; cedar chest; half size 3 drawer chest; 2 drawer walnut stand on tripod base; dovetailed Pennsylvania cradle; 2 organ stools; carved table bases; wood box; wood tool chests; office desks; school desks; parlor desks; bedroom desks; oak harmonica display case; rope bed and goodness only knows what all other kinds of beds; cedar wardrobe; feed bin; walnut bedroom suite; early American pine dry bar; china closet; oak bureau w/tall mirror; print "Marriage of Pocohontas" and oil by G. Our project on this particular day will be to sell racks, counters, cupboards and equipment, plus the contents of three 30 ft. storage trailers and one 20 ft. x 50 ft. enclosed storage shed. Some of this material is new, some will be antique and the rest is junk. (Scrap dealers should attend.) Expect to buy more glass, china, silver plate, new and used housewares, assorted tools and hardware. Rotating screw cabinet; two matching multi-drawer oak display cupboards; hardware sample boards; legs; shelving; brackets; grass seed; bird baths; stoneware; planters and pots; yard and garden tools; Ortho products; new TV antenna; post lamp posts; paints and stains; garden supplies; cash register; stereo; oak nail bin; steel dentist's cupboard; iron laundry stove; iron cookstove; wood stoves and large kero space heater; brand new roto tiller; brand new cordless 19 inch twin motor mowers; church pews; styrofoam beams; about 50 odd and antique chairs; new Flexible Flyer sleds; barber chair; barber shop bench; strawberry boxes; farm wagon (a large horse drawn
