GNR eggs are classified by weight in 30-dozen cases, and traded in lots of either 300 or 750 cases. Prices are FOB buyers dock, and are computed Tuesday and Thursday of each week.  Market Comment: Movement on ready to cook whole birds is fair at best with most processors indicating disappointment in today's demand. Parts are moving better than whole birds, but here again the demand is not that aggressive, and interest centers on leg quarters and wings. Today's LTL asking prices are unchanged on U.S. Grade A at 58 to 63 cents, but additional product is still being discounted in several quarters.
 Slaughter is moderate as an occasional plant is not operating today. Live supplies are adequate at improving but still irregular weights. Undertone steady.
