

# 508 counties eligible for aid

COLLEGE STATION, Tex. — Secretary of Agriculture John R. Block today said 508 more counties nationwide are now eligible for Farmers Home Administration emergency loans which were initiated due to 1983 weather disasters. He also said deadlines on applying for loans have been extended.

Both actions result from the Emergency Agricultural Credit Act of 1984, which was signed into law April 10

by President Reagan. It authorizes emergency loans for counties which are contiguous to counties already named as eligible for loans due to losses from natural disasters occurring after May 30, 1983. Including the additional counties, 2,092 are now eligible nationwide for loans.

The new law sets the deadline for making loan applications at eight months after the date the Secretary designates a county eligible. Previously, the

deadline was six months.

Block said USDA interprets this to mean that, in most cases, farmers in all eligible counties of a state can apply for an emergency loan anytime during an eight-month period following the date in which the last county of their particular state was designated as eligible.

All counties which are eligible for emergency loans are also eligible for a livestock feed assistance program administered by the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service, Block added.

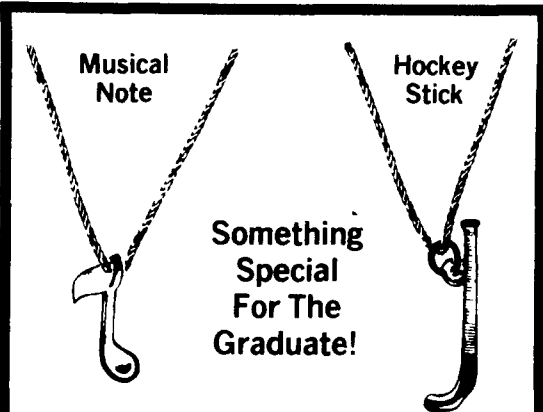

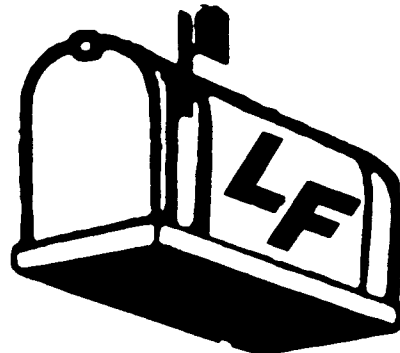

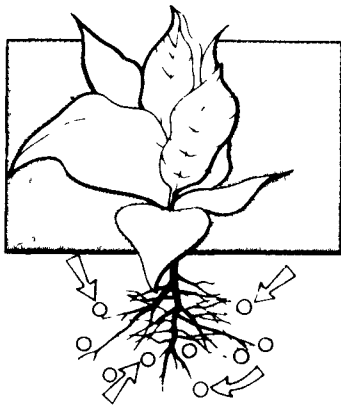
