Gehl cylinders are built to take the load you put into them. The cylinder on the 1250 is a full 25 1/2" wide with nine knives — all tungsten-carbide faced for longer life and a high quality cut. With short bevel knives you get less chipping and longer edge life — easier sharpening, and the 17 1/2° angle reduces vibration.
