Unique Pennsylvania German tall-case clock with profuse bone and wood inlay in distleflink and hex designs, height 79", inlay signed and dated; "IC 1785".

Fine Pennsylvania c. 1800 tiger maple tall-case clock, height 95".

Signed marble sculpture, "Horse Pulling Stone-Laden Cart," earliest known work by pre-eminent 19th century American sculptor William Rimmer (1816-79) with documentation

Highly important 18th century early Georgian mechanical armchair.

FURNITURE: Very large 19th century pine cupboard; 19th century executive chair from U.S. House of Representatives, with Congressional seal, 19th century slant-topped, high legged chestnut postal desk; eleven foot long deacon's bench; antique Hepplewhite corner cabinet; antique Hepplewhite mechanical reading table; 17th-18th century 12 sided table with cameo marquetry and parquetry, on ornately carved supports; 19th century dictionary stand; 19th century French vitrine; antique Louis XIII center table inlaid with ivory, lapis lazuli, brass and pewter; 19th century Boule turtle-shaped bureau plat; other antique American and European furniture.

OIL PAINTINGS: Signed works by J.H. Carmiencke; H.H. Cross; H.W. Kemper; G.W. Lambert; H. McCulloch; F.L. Mora; E. Moran; E. Walters. Many other signed paintings by listed artists. Unsigned 18th-20th century paintings and prints.

CLOCKS, WATCHES AND RELATED ITEMS: Tortoise-shell pear cased watch by Thomas Thompson, c. 1685; 19th century swiss 6 tune musical clock with 49 animated figures and other complex functions.
