Tours were also conducted of the facilities.

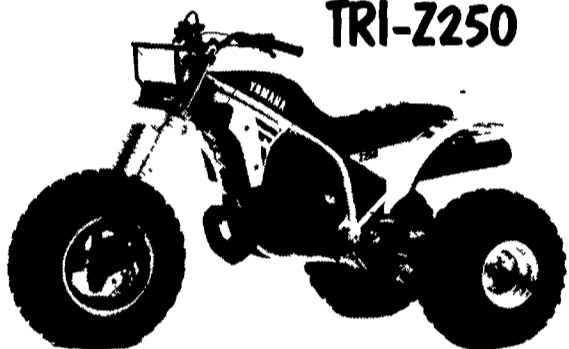
