During the month there were 92 herds with 4,975 cows processed in the DHIA program, according to Russell C Seward, County Agent. Production ranged from a high of 59.9 pounds of milk, testing 3.8 percent fat, to a low of 25.4 pounds of milk, testing 4.1 percent fat.

In the owner-sampler program there were 17 herds with 628 cows being processed. The herds ranged from a high of 53.1 pounds of milk, testing 3.7 percent fat, to a low of 25.2 pounds of milk, testing 3.5 percent fat.

The ten high individual cow actual production records in DHIA produced on a two times a day milking in 305 days or less (unless otherwise indicated) were in the following herds:
