CLINTON COUNTY DHIA April Report

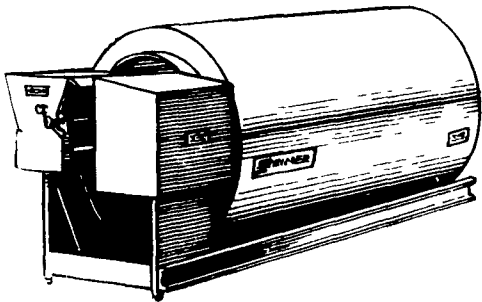
LOCK HAVEN -- Tom & Grace Nicholas led the Clinton County Dairy Herd Improvement Association for April 1984. The top herd in the Clinton County DHIA for April is owned by Tom & Grace Nicholas, while the cow completing the highest lactation was owned by Paul Dotterer. The top herd of Registered Holsteins completed the month with a Rolling Herd Average of 18000 pounds of milk per cow yielding 704 pounds of butterfat. Other top herds were: — Paul Courter, 18455 pounds of milk, 704 pounds of butterfat; — Terry & Deb Dickey, 18052 pounds of milk, 676 pounds of butterfat; — Anthony & Caroline Graine, 18930 pounds of milk, 663 pounds of butterfat.

— #87, a 3½-year-old Holstein owned by Paul Dotterer #87 produced 22271 pounds of milk testing at 4.5 percent, yielding 1002 pounds of butterfat in 305 days. — Jenny, owned by Paul L. Courter, 19200 pounds of milk, 4.6 percent, 892 pounds of butterfat. — Dixie, owned by Paul L. Courter, 19492 pounds of milk, 4.3 percent, 836 pounds of butterfat. — Rosetta, owned by Paul L. Courter, 22055 pounds of milk, 3.7 percent, 817 pounds of butterfat. — #51, owned by Walk-Way Farms, 26781 pounds of milk, 3.0 percent, 807 pounds of butterfat. — Mae, owned by Samuel S. King, 19246 pounds of milk, 4.1 percent, 798 pounds of butterfat. — Beth, owned by Ward and Keith Carson, 28464 pounds of milk, 2.8 percent, 796 pounds of butterfat. — #117, owned by Paul Dotterer, 22032 pounds of milk, 3.4 percent, 758 pounds of butterfat. — Daisy, owned by Paul L. Courter, 17320 pounds of milk, 4.3 percent, 750 pounds of butterfat.

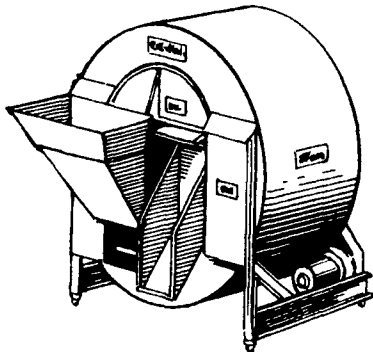

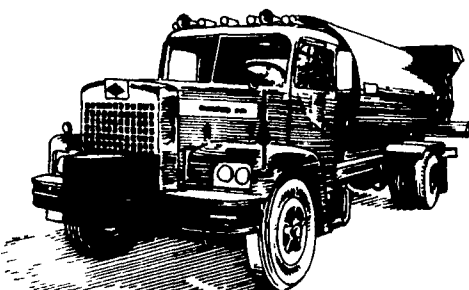

TRUCK MOUNTED

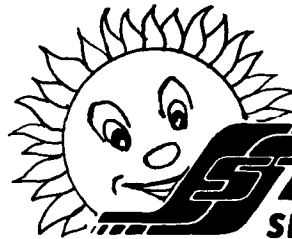
