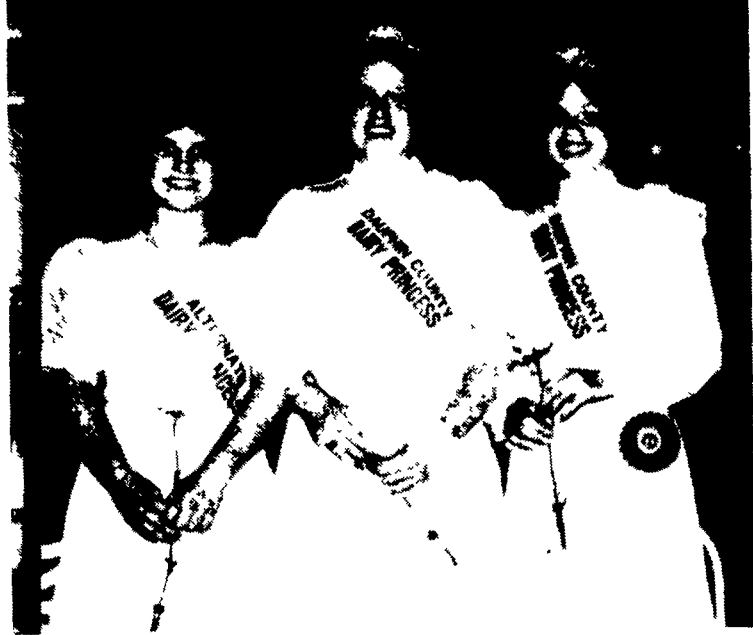


## Dauphin Co. dairy princess crown stays in family

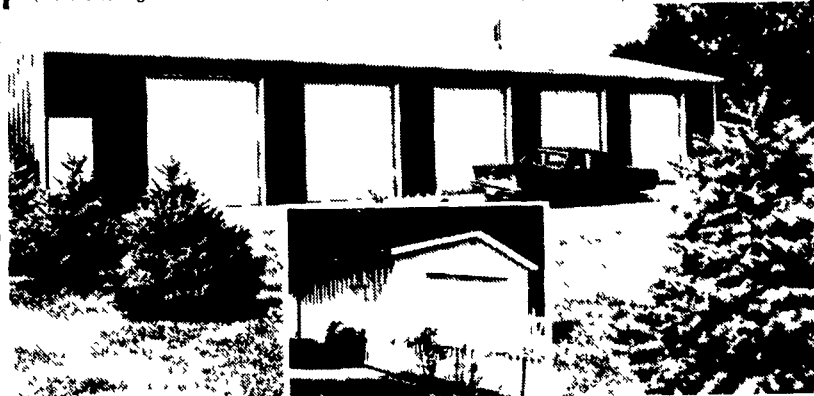
