During the month there were 103 herds with 5,416 cows processed in DHIA program, according to Russel C Seward County Agent Production ranged from a high of 60 1 pounds of milk testing 3 9 percent fat, to a low of 22 3 pounds of milk testing 4 7 percent fat

In the owner sampler program there were 13 herds with 509 cows being processed The herds ranged from a high of 53 1 pounds of milk testing 3 7 percent fat, to a low of 22 5 pounds of milk, testing 3 4 percent fat
