

PennAg convention speakers named

EPHRATA — PennAg Industries Association will hold its 106th annual convention at the Host Farm 2, Lancaster, from Sunday, Sept. 23, through Wednesday, Sept. 26.

Guest speakers for the convention include George Herman, long-time CBS News Correspondent, who will be speaking on the economic issues relating to the 1984 Presidential Campaign. Also featured are Alvin Oliver, executive vice president of the National Grain and Feed Association, and Oakley Ray, president of the American Feed Manufacturer's Association. In addition, a luncheon has been planned to feature Edward Mezzvinsky, Esq., Chairman of the Democratic Party in Pennsylvania and an unconfirmed representative from the White House. Congressman Bob Walker will also be on hand to answer questions.

A legislative board has been set up to include Noah Wenger, Pa. Senator and Vice Chairman of the Agriculture Committee; Samuel Morris, Pa. Representative and Chairman of the House Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee; and June Honaman, Pa. Representative and member of the House Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee.

Millersville University and an expert on Pa. politics; Dr. Samuel Smith, Dean of the College of Agriculture at Penn State University; and Dr. Robert Marshak, Dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. Also included is Nancy Kulp, Democratic Candidate for Congress from the 9th district of Pa. and former star of the TV series "The Beverly Hillbillies."

Two seminars will be held, one on Personal computers given by Mike Reardon and the other on Creative Business and Personal Finance given by Michael Collins.

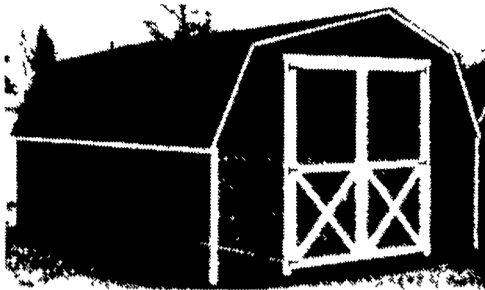

Queen Rd Storage Barns are built to order, carefully, by hand, the way a carpenter builds a house. Standard wood framing techniques and materials are used, scaled to shed dimensions. Two 4 x 4 pressure treated tumer skids form the foundation runners. Five 4 x 4 pressure treated tumber skids are under 10' and 12' wide sheds. Floor joists are standard 2 x 4's spaced 16 inches on center, and covered with 5/8" plywood flooring. Studs 2 x 3 in. frame the walls and are used in the rafter trusses — also spaced 16 in. on center. Roof trusses are designed to give maximum headroom over most of the floor area. The roof consists of exterior grade plywood sheathing and shingled with 240 lb asphalt roof shingles. Wood grain 1/2" residential T-1-11 exterior plywood siding finishes the exterior.

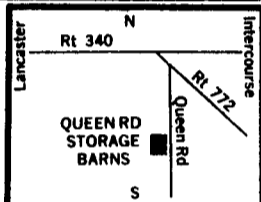

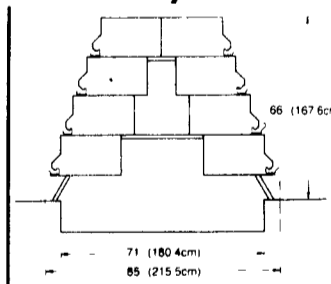
