Other prices received were: oak dry sink \$600, drop leaf table \$220, schoolmasters desk \$625, small egg basket \$85 and tulip quilt \$450.

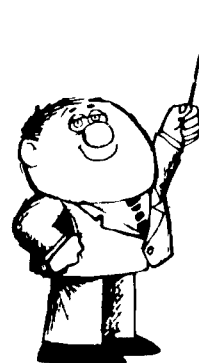
